BOAT TYPE: Fishing Powerboat

INTRO:

VILA 570 is the smallest of a family of three small planing cruisers boats ranging from 19' to 22'.

DESCRIPTION:

The Vila are female fairy figures in Slav mythology. We gave this name to our small motor cruisers as their design developed from a project tied to the Balkan world: of navigating the Donau and the Sava rivers in Serbia starting from Belgrade. This means thousands of kilometres of internal waters which offer numerous possibilities for touring and discovery. The boats are also suitable for other types of navigation: VILA 570 is conceived mainly for fast, but peaceful, navigations along the coast in protected waters. It is also very suited to fishing, with some variants in deck layout or in the cockpit, which the constructor may carry out according to the fishing technique. The hull has an accentuated V shape at the bow, so as to allow it to pass smoothly over the wave but the deadrise at the stern is moderate to favour planing even with a 40 HP motor. The construction, in stitch and glue, is very simple.
